

next General Elections, we shall request you to put us back into power in order to enable us to complete what we have started and bring it to full fruition.

10. The Opposition Parties have shown satisfaction when Chiefs continue to dispossess people of their lands unlawfully. We, on the Government side, condemn this type of conduct. We know that the nation is not happy. The nation is not satisfied with land allocation and deprivation. In the circumstances we have instituted a Commission to investigate and report on your views on this thorny question. Your views will bring this matter to finality.
11. In the private sector we encourage all industrialists and employers to allow Basotho financial participation in all forms of business and industry started in this country. We insist on re-investment of profits in Lesotho for the development of the country. We do not allow this country to be bled to death by the drainage of its wealth. Our people should be trained for ultimate take-over in both the public and the private sectors. The nett result will be equal pay for equal work.
12. We have not changed our policy on the question of political refugees. We shall continue to accept all political refugees on condition that they do not meddle in our domestic political platform from which to speak politics of any kind. We shall not allow them to make our country their springboard against any Government. We repeat and we want to emphasise publicly that no political refugee will be returned to the country from which he fled when he sought refuge in our country.
13. The Government is worried about the present large-scale importation and distribution of communist literature in this country. My advice to those who bring them in is that they should forthwith cease doing so. This is a Christian country...../3.
