

to be, Mr. Clifford, one of a firm of building contractors in Maseru, has informed me that soon in the course of this year he will establish in Maseru a glassware industry which will employ about 400 Basotho men. These are the fruits of happy co-operation between Government and some white businessmen who at sometime were labelled "blood-suckers, fleas and Stepladders" by the opposition camps. We shall continue to construct more and more water-supplies and wells. By the end of this year there will be completed 139 wells supplying villages with clean drinking water. The Self-Help Campaign will continue to construct roads, dams and plant trees - these will be in addition to what the Self-Help Campaign has already achieved in spite of the Opposition and their attempts to destroy all the good for which our People are paying large sums of money to achieve through their blood and sweat; but Government is seriously considering what drastic measures it will have to take against these enemies and saboteurs. As animal husbandry and Agriculture are a mainstay of our economy, we will have to co-operate with Government in counteracting hostile and wicked forces which intend to dishearten us in our praiseworthy and socially desirable services for national development, nation-building, general improvement of the land on which we and our live-stock depend. Again, we must assist Government in combating stock-theft perpetrated by loafers and good-for-nothing vagabonds - enemies of the Nation.
