

whenever they want to be met halfway. The road linking up Kolonyama, Fobane, Mapoteng and Ficksburg at 'Matumo's Nek has already been surveyed through the efforts of the Self-Help Campaign.

This Government, in their attempt to satisfy the people's complaints regarding allocation and deprivation of lands which obviously certain chiefs and headmen allocate and deprive people of their lands contrary to the provisions of the constitution and other relevant laws in this Country and also because some courts do not make any redress in these matters where the Constitution and the laws provide for protection of the people's rights - advised His Majesty to have formed a Commission of Inquiry after whose findings will report to Government who will, in turn, take immediate and necessary steps to safeguard the people's lands and bring before the courts of law those liable. But, over and above this, I see no reason why the Nation should not enjoy the use of their lands as heritage in the same way as the chiefs themselves do - the land, according to the Constitution, is the heritage of the people. You will but wonder why Mokhehle disagrees with the step Government is taking to protect the People's rights to their lands. Again, Mokhehle himself, Gauda Khasu and Koenyama Chakela stubbornly reject Governments' establishing of industries in Lesotho. One asks oneself if these are also the views subscribed to by the people when, on the other hand, we know that you need protection against deprivation of your lands by chiefs and also industries where you will work without having to travel long distances.

I shall have failed in my duty if I did not touch on the way in which Ntsu Mokhehle and the Congress Party are notorious for attacking the Churches of God which, besides being "Shepherds of our souls" have built us schools where our children learn, and other,.../5.
